

Expectations and Scheduling Conflict Form

Theater camp requires regular attendance. Others in the cast are depending on your children to be there to say their lines, to sing their solos or to be their dance partner. It is extremely important that we can count on your child being at camp each day and at both performances: Thursday evening, July 21, and Friday afternoon July 22.

Expectations:

We expect that campers will be at camp each day unless you have indicated on the form below that the child has a conflict and will need to miss a few hours. Conflicts are doctor's appointment or something that cannot easily be rescheduled.

We expect that campers will arrive by 9 am each morning and that they will be picked up promptly at 3 pm.

We ask for help from campers' parents to assist in costuming, and we expect parents to help campers by running lines and helping them to know their songs.

We expect that campers will bring a water bottle, a snack for mid-morning and a hearty lunch to keep them going through the day!

Kindness, cooperation and respect are expected of all campers, staff and families.
